Goal of 127

The Clean Energy for a Healthy Arizona initiative, Proposition 127, would require that utility companies in Arizona to source electricity from an increasing percentage of renewable resources each year, increasing annually from 12 % in 2020 to 50% in 2030.

Supporter Positions

- Requiring this standard will improve the air quality in Arizona
- Tucson, Phoenix, and Yuma are ranked among the worst air quality cities in the country
- Research shows that 1 in 9 Arizona children suffer from asthma due in part to air quality.

Opposer Positions

Those who oppose state that this initiative is projected to double the monthly electricity bill for the average Arizona household, costing a typical family more than \$1,000 over the course of the year.
