Arizona Prop 305

What does Prop 305 Propose?

Prop 305 is a ballot initiative designed to allow Arizona students who choose not to attend public schools to receive public funding for private education.

This means that state education dollars are being diverted away from our public schools, which are already under-funded.

In addition to some of the lowest teacher salaries in the nation, Arizona has 941-1 student to social worker ratio, which is the worst in the country.

This affects not only the education children of survivors may receive, but also the availability of services they may utilize. This places undue strain on survivors who are mothers, and for this reason ACESDV opposes Prop 305.
