

# Prop 306: Arizona Unlawful Contributions from Clean Election Accounts and Commission Rulemaking Requirements

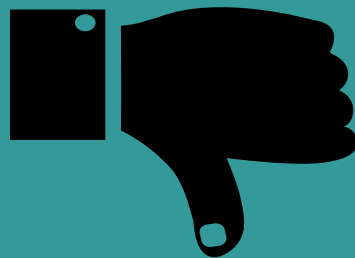


## The 2 Goals:

1. Stop political parties and 501 (a) agencies from running candidates solely to collect money from public financing accounts for other candidate elections purposes.

2. Remove the Citizens Clean Election Commission's (CCEC) ability to finalize rules for the public financing program and would require them to receive approval from the Governor's Regulatory Review Council (GRRC). This takes away some of the CCEC's power and gives it to the 7 members of the GRRC that the Governor appoints.

Our Position: **Oppose**



While this is not specifically a sexual or domestic violence services measure, it would have impact on the Citizen Clean Elections Commission that can indirectly impact them.

- This change could have an impact on who receives public funding based on the political party of the GRRC.

-This could potentially create obstacles for more community-based candidates who have less economic opportunity.
